It IS (It's)	It IS NOT (It isn't)	IS it dirty?
We ARE (We're)	We ARE NOT (We aren't)	ARE we freezing?
You ARE (you're)	You ARE NOT (You aren't)	ARE you tired?
They ARE (They're)	They ARE NOT (They aren't)	ARE they cold?


